



# Steps for Intraoral Scanning Success

1

Check for calculus, food, or plaque on teeth

2

Dry all tooth surfaces using air (where available) or a cotton roll

3

Prevent fogging of the scanning tip by checking the glass and securing sleeve (where applicable)

4

Pay attention to second molars, mesial of premolars and gingival of incisors. More anatomy is better!

5

Prevent patients from moving their jaw when scanning their interocclusal bite
